## YEAR 1 Learning Overview TERMS 5 & 6: Into The Woods & Amazing Animals and Buzzing Bees

# Reading

Daily Read Write Inc. sessions every week will be dedicated to phonics, fluency and comprehension. Children will have a daily story read at the end of each day, along with regular opportunities to read in the classroom and in provision. Please continue to read at home daily and add this to Boom Reader.

Using our key texts, the children will continue to develop important key writing skills, including using capital letters and full stops, using interesting adjectives, using time conjunctions to sequence events and using connectives to join sentences together. We are also working on letter formation.

Writing


In Maths, the children will begin by exploring numbers to 100. The children will learn about equal groups to help them with multiplication and division. To conclude the year, we will learn about halves and guarters and will explore money and telling the time.

## Science

In Science, the children will be learning about plants and animals, including humans. We will be able to name parts of a plant (including leaves, petals, roots, seed, trunk, branches, stem) and the human body. 
