


Reading will continue to take place daily in Terms 1 and 2. Five Read Write Inc. sessions a week will be dedicated to phonics, fluency, comprehension and inference. Using our quality key texts, the children will continue to develop important key writing skills by retelling and sequencing narratives, constructing diary entries and creating information pages based on non-fiction texts. Children will also work on their descriptive skills, writing interesting and creative pieces.

During Term 1 and 2, the children will continue to develop their understanding of place value, addition and subtraction. We will be learning to identify the tens and ones in two-digit numbers and will be learning to count in 1s, 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. We will also deepen our knowledge on shape in Term 2.

In Science, we will be learning about electricity, exploring circuits, Investigating conductivity and learning all about electricity safety. In Term 2, we will begin to investigate materials and matter, discovering the properties of materials and performing fun experiments surrounding solids and liquids.
