

Reading

Reading will continue to take place daily. Four sessions a week will be dedicated to reading a focus paragraph developing our fluency (reading aloud with automaticity) and answering comprehension questions. One session a week will aim to develop a real love of reading through a variety of activities. Please continue to read at home daily.

Writing

Our Key texts will become the models for looking at narrative and non-fiction styles of writing. We will look at structures authors use and build up a bank of vocabulary and phrases to use in our own writing. Our lessons will be active and memorable to immerse in the style of text. Through the sequences we will practise our grammar and punctuation skills. We will also practise new skills to write our own rhyming poetry and sets of instructions.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will begin to learn all about fractions. We will be increasing our knowledge and be able to identify unit and non-unit fractions. We will be developing our problem solving skills to ensure we are able to identify what maths questions are asking us to do. We will then move on to Shape, Mass and Capacity.

Science

In Science this term we will be looking at how plants grow and identifying the parts and functions of a reproducing plant. We will carry our investigations to find out best conditions for plants to grow. Through our experiments we learn about the importance of fair testing. We will learn how to measure and observe changes over time and record our findings.

History

We are travelling back in time and learning all about the Stone Age! We will be understanding all of the different periods of time and how their lives compared and differed to ours today.

Geography

In Geography, we are finding out about Skara Brae and why it was important. We will also be discovering Stonehenge and how evidence about this can give us different views about the past.

Art & DT

In Art, we will be designing and creating our own clay model. We will learn about the colour wheel in painting and we will be using the artist Leonid Afremov as our inspiration. In DT we will be designing and creating our own Fruit Salad using British grown fruits.

PE

Indoor PE – This term we will be learning to play the team game of Rounders. We will then be focusing on Athletics and building our spatial awareness.
Outdoor PE – The Brighton and Hove Coaches will be teaching the children ball skills and other skills related to a variety of sports.

MFL

We will be continuing our French journey with learning different instruments as well as saying which ones we can play. As the weather becomes hotter ice creams and our favorite fruits are on the cards learning about colours and flavours. PSHE & Computing

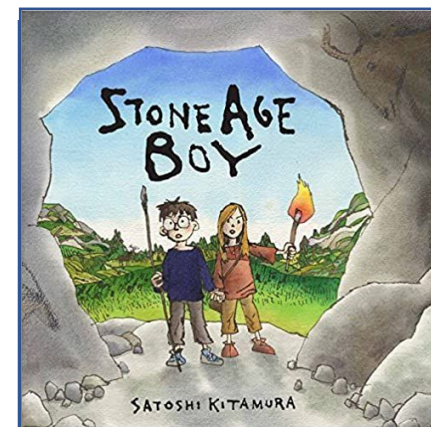
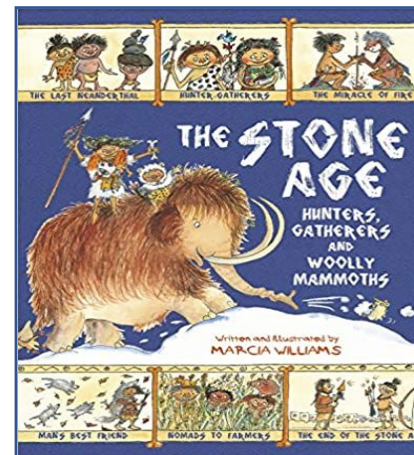
